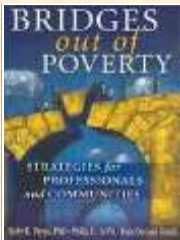
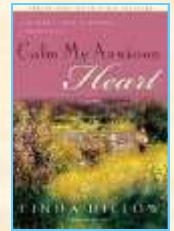
## Here and Now... There and Then: by Beth Moore
