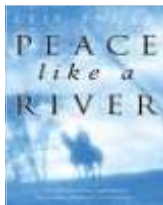

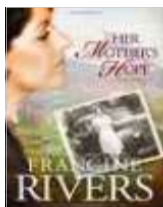

Peace Like A River



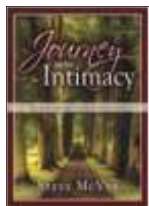

Single's Wednesday Night Five Lies that Ruin Relationships

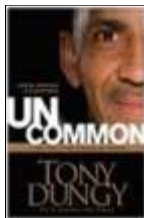

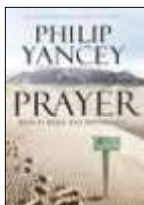

Prayer: Does It Make Any Difference?

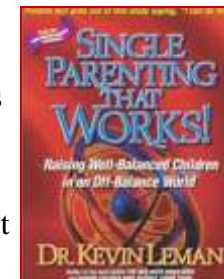
