Contemporary Choir

Traditional Choirs

Chancel Choir

Sings at 11:00 am Traditional Worship Service on Sunday morning throughout the year with a few weeks off in summer. The choir prepares special music or a Cantata for Christmas and Easter seasons. Members of this choir prepare solos and small ensemble pieces used in worship. An Annual Retreat is held in early Autumn. Social functions are held throughout the year celebrating major **choir projects and members' birthdays.**

Open to Adults including high school age.

Chancel Handbell Choir

Plays anthems, accompanies Chancel Choir and Congregational singing—usually for Traditional Services. Two major celebrative social functions are held each year with the Chancel Choir.

Rehearsals: Wed, 6:00-7:00 pm, Sanctuary
Open to Adults including high school age.



Sunrise Choir

Sings at 8:15 am Traditional Service on Sunday morning through most of the year.

Rehearsals:

Sunday mornings 7:45 – 8:05 am, Sanctuary
Open to Adults including high school age.

Williamson's Chapel Orchestra

The orchestra will play a couple services each year with rehearsals scheduled for a few weeks prior. Instrumentalists will be used throughout the year as soloists or in small ensembles to add their unique sound to the music worship.
